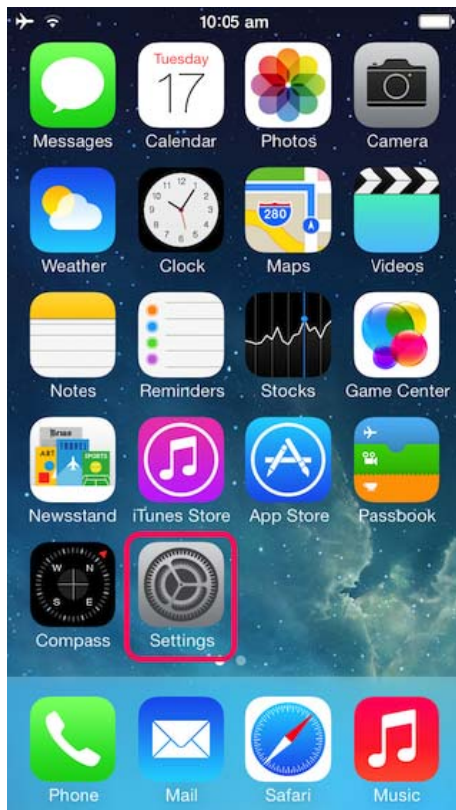


Adding an Email Account on Your iPhone

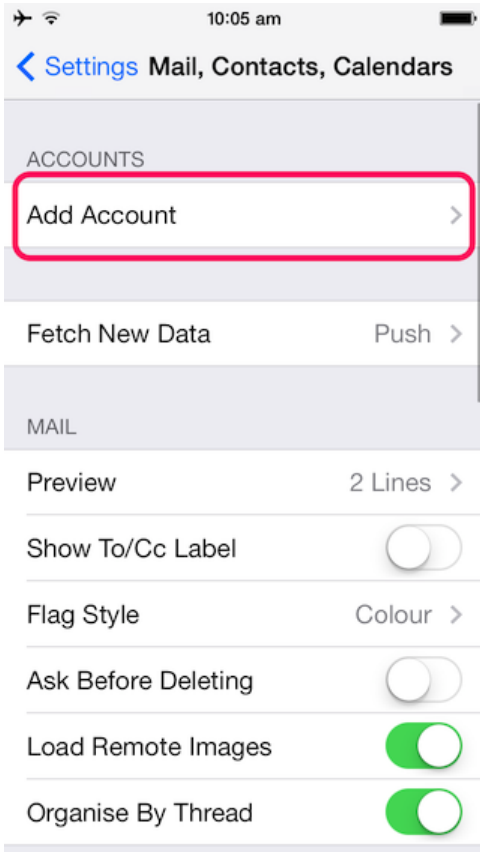
Follow these instructions to add an email account on your iPhone, iPad, or iPod touch.



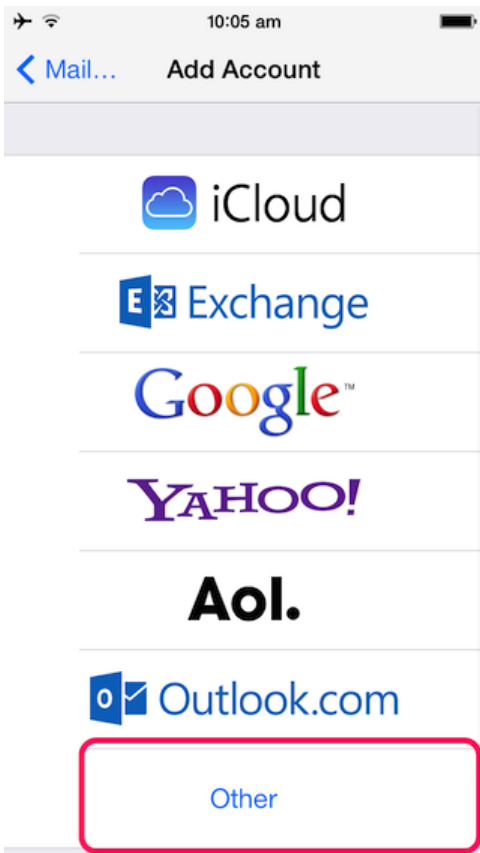
1. Tap Settings



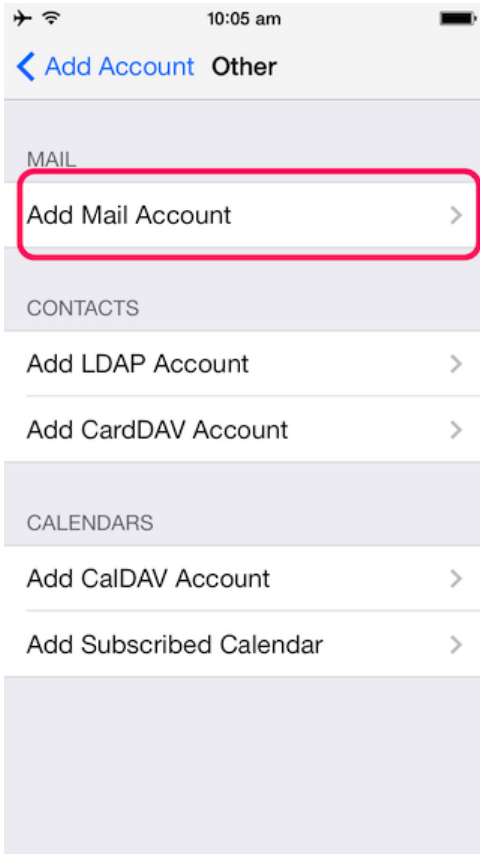
2. Scroll down and select 'Mail, Contact, Calendars'.



3. Tap Add Account



4. Scroll down and select 'Other'.



5. Select 'Add Mail Account'.



6. Enter the following:
- Enter your name
 - Enter your email address
 - Enter your password
 - Enter a description for the account (optional)
 - Press 'Next'



7. Select either POP or IMAP

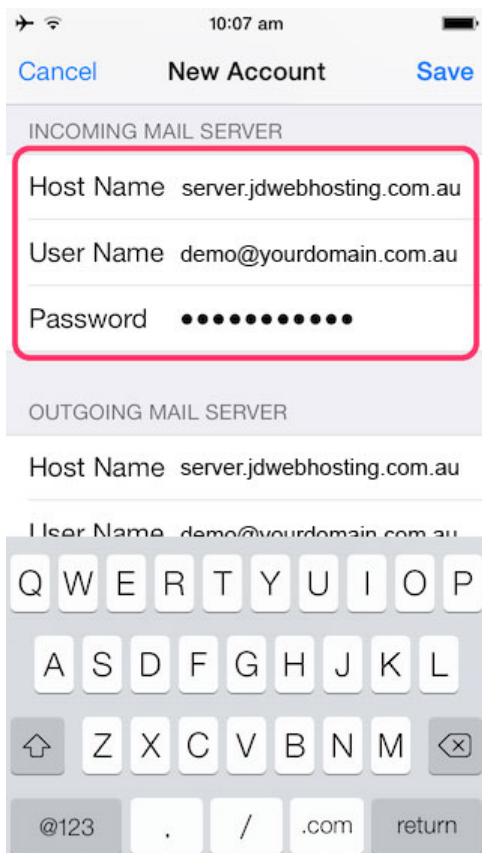
If you only use your phone or mobile device for receiving emails use POP.

If you use a combination of mobile and computer choose IMAP for the mobile and POP for the computer. **(recommended)**

Or

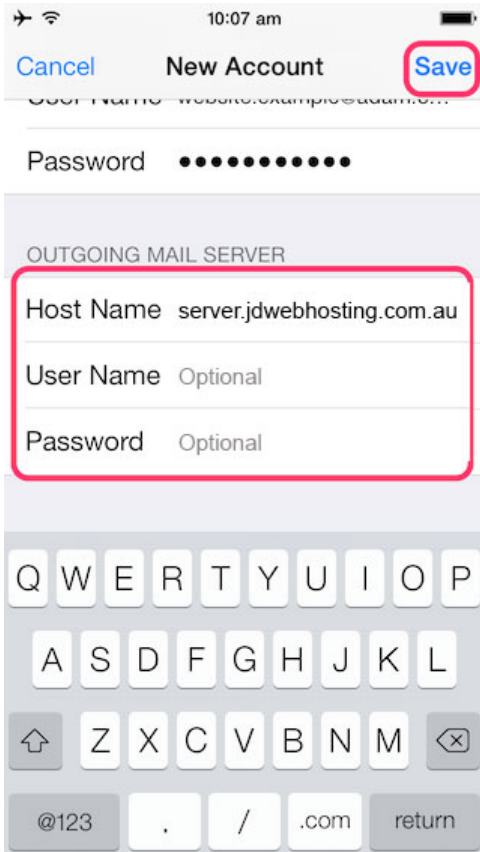
Use IMAP for both mobile and computer, but be warned you must make sure you regularly delete old messages or your mailbox will become full and block you out.

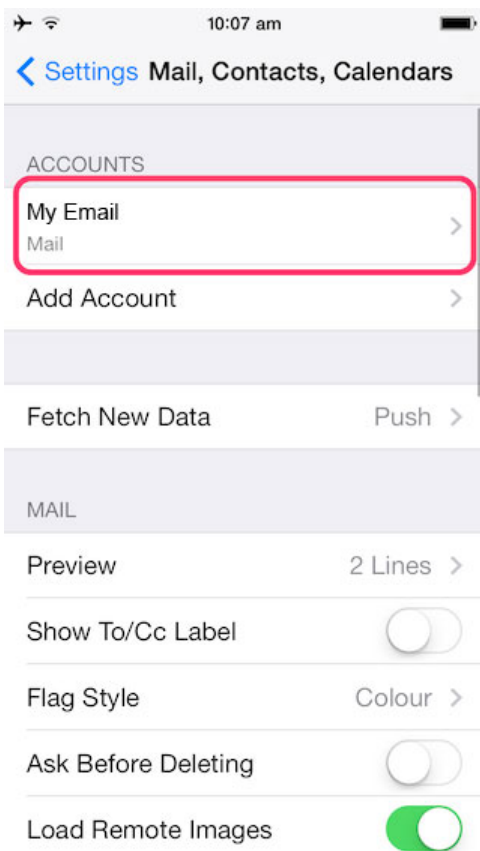
8. Enter 'Incoming Mail Server' settings:

- Host Name is 'server.jdwebhosting.com.au'
- User name is your email address
- Password is your password



9. Scroll down and enter 'Outgoing Mail Server' settings.

- Host Name is 'server.jdwebhosting.com.au'
- You don't need to enter username and password
- Press 'Save'



10. You should now see the new email account which you have created.

Press the home button to return to the home screen.

To add more email accounts, repeat the above steps.
